#### Installation in brief

- Floor should be clean, dry & dust-free.
- Secure loose floorboards and hammer in any protruding nails.
- Lay dry boards in staggered pattern, leaving 5mm gap at room edges.
- Damp-proof membrane to be applied first on damp floors, in cellars
   & ground floor above unheated rooms.
- Full instructions on back of label.

# Classic Underlay



#### **Surface Preparation**

- → Ensure the floor is clean, dry and dust-free.
- → Any loose floorboards and protruding nails should be hammered down.
- → If the floor is damp, it must be isolated using a vapour tight polythene damp proof membrane.
- → A membrane must always be applied in cellars or on ground floors above unheated rooms.

#### **Laying Instructions**



The underlay boards can be easily cut using a knife.




The boards must be kept dry.



Lay the boards in a staggered pattern to spread the joints.



Leave a 5mm gap around the edge of the room.



Always lay final floor covering as directed by the manufacturer.
